TENUTO CONTO del decreto adottato dal Ministro della Salute di concerto con il Ministero dell'Istruzione dell'Università e della Ricerca in data 26 gennaio 2010, con il quale è stato approvato il programma di ricerca finalizzata per l'anno 2009;

VISTO il bando dal titolo " Bando Ricerca Finalizzata 2009" pubblicato in data 05 febbraio 2010 che finanzia sia i progetti di "ricerca finalizzata" sia i progetti per i "giovani ricercatori" per un importo complessivo di € 101.482.381,00 (centounomilioni quattrocentottantadue milatrecentottantuno/00);

Il **Dott. Massimo Casciello**, Direttore Generale della Ricerca Scientifica e Tecnologia, porge il benvenuto ai presenti ed illustra il lavoro del Gruppo di Consenso esponendo la situazione delle valutazioni dei circa 1.600 progetti presentati. Sottolinea la libertà di decisione da parte dei componenti sulla prassi da adottare per l'attribuzione del giudizio sulla base delle proprie esperienze e professionalità.

Puntualizza che il giudizio dovrà essere espresso sulla scientificità e traslazonalità dei progetti al fine di individuare i migliori, con la precisazione che la scelta dei progetti da finanziare, come previsto nel Bando, sia equamente distribuita nelle aree clinico-assistenziale e biomedica traslazionale. Suggerisce, inoltre, che il giudizio avvenga sempre collegialmente.

Comunica che il *Prof. Vito Campese* assumerà, se il gruppo è d'accordo, l'incarico di coordinatore dei lavori.

Presenta quindi il *Dott. Gaetano Guglielmi*, Direttore dell'Ufficio III di questa Direzione Generale che sarà il referente per qualsiasi problema legato al sistema informativo nonché per concordare la definizione delle modalità e procedure da seguire nel corso della study session e la *Dott.ssa M. Novella Luciani*, Direttore dell'Ufficio IV di questa Direzione Generale che sarà la

referente per i dettagli organizzativi e per i rapporti nella fase audit con la Commissione Nazionale per la Ricerca Sanitaria, ed entrambi sono a disposizione per ogni chiarimento relativo alle disposizioni contenute nel Bando.

Stifani interviene per rappresentare che le sue reviews saranno trascritte in lingua inglese e chiede, se possibile, di definire il cut off per i progetti finanziabili sulla base della disponibilità dei fondi.

Casciello riferisce che il tetto massimo di finanziamento ministeriale, così come previsto nel Bando, è pari a € 600.000,00, ferma restando la possibilità di cofinanziamenti di soggetti terzi anche superiori a tale cifra e che la lingua inglese è quella ufficiale; rispondendo alla seconda domanda, si può ipotizzare un numero dei progetti finanziabili di circa 140, ricordando che il numero deve essere equamente distribuito tra biomedici e traslazionali, nonché puntualizza, quindi, che il cut off di finanziamento possa essere diverso tra le due tipologie.

Guglielmi, con l'ausilio di slides, allegate al verbale (All. n.1), illustra un grafico di presentazione sulle tematiche dei progetti suddivise in clinico-assistenziale e ricerca biomedica e la tabella riassuntiva dello stato delle valutazioni (All. n.2).

Campese, nell'avviare i lavori, suggerisce di iniziare con l'attribuzione dei giudizi ai progetti che non presentano alcuna valutazione, per poi procedere con quelli che ne presentano una soltanto; pertanto, avvia l'attività di referaggio con l'esame dei 22 progetti con 0 valutazioni sui 1600 presentati, per poi procedere con quelli che non sono stati valutati da almeno due revisori, effettuando un triage che consenta di escludere quelli che non hanno possibilità di founding.

Il Gruppo procede, quindi all'assegnazione dei progetti che non presentano alcuna valutazione, come da seguente schema:

I componenti del Gruppo proseguono individualmente nelle valutazioni dei progetti assegnati e continuano successivamente con quelli che presentano una sola valutazione (~~numero~~).

Al termine di questa procedura il Gruppo di Consenso discute tali progetti revisionati in maniera collegiale e il risultato di tale fase di valutazione è riportato nell'allegato n. 3.

Campese richiede la visualizzazione dell'attuale graduatoria dei progetti alla luce delle ultime valutazioni espresse.

Il Gruppo, constatato che tutti i progetti hanno ottenuto almeno due giudizi decide, al fine di verificare l'esistenza di eventuali incongruità nella procedura di valutazione, di riesaminare in maniera collegiale quei progetti che presentano eccessive discordanze di punteggio ad esclusione di quelli con face to face concluso (numero preciso).

In questa analisi il Gruppo effettuerà anche la rivalutazione dei progetti con face to face non terminato (cioè già avviato e non concluso o mai iniziato tra i tre reviews) verificando se il punteggio finale non è adeguatamente sostenuto dal giudizio.

Per quanto riguarda questi progetti il Gruppo di Consenso decide di procedere come segue:

- nel caso in cui le valutazioni espresse dai valutatori NIH risultino congrue, il Gruppo conferma collegialmente il punteggio finale, derivante dalla media dei punteggi espressi dai valutatori.
- nel caso in cui le valutazioni espresse dai valutatori NIH non siano ritenute accettabili integralmente da parte dei componenti, il Gruppo esamina collegialmente il progetto e attribuisce un nuovo punteggio sostitutivo di quelli espressi dai valutatori NIH, motivandolo in modo adeguato. I risultati di tale fase sono riportati nell'allegato n. 4.

Il Panel segnala la presenza di progetti molto simili presentati da gruppi di lavoro uguali.

Il Gruppo di Consenso decide, all'unanimità, che questo comportamento è inaccettabile e propone, alla Commissione Nazionale per la Ricerca Sanitaria, l'esclusione di questi progetti dal finanziamento. Suggestisce, inoltre, di regolamentare in modo chiaro, nel prossimo Bando, questa situazione. In assenza di regole precise i progetti, in questa fase, sono stati comunque inclusi nella lista finale.

Infine, dopo verifica della coerenza del giudizio espresso con il punteggio attribuito, il Gruppo di Consenso collegialmente procede alla stesura della graduatoria finale e per maggiore

sicurezza decide di riesaminare tutti i progetti compresi nell'area potenzialmente finanziabile, al fine di identificare eventuali ulteriori imprecisioni.

In questa fase, avendo ristretto il numero dei progetti, si avvia una peer-review tra i progetti potenzialmente finanziabili e cioè quelli con un punteggio prossimo al finanziamento.


Tale attività genera la stesura della graduatoria finale dei progetti che il Comitato approva all'unanimità e che viene allegata come parte integrante del presente verbale.






